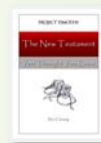
These are just some of the things we learn in Project Timothy.

PT 2 opens by exploring the books that define the Hebraic view of wisdom as an orientation to God. Then we read the prophetic writings in the approximate chronological order of their final forms, beginning with Amos and ending with Isaiah.



PT 3 starts with the earliest writings of the New Testament, James and Galatians. Next come other Pauline and Petrine epistles, according to the chronological order of their final forms.
